

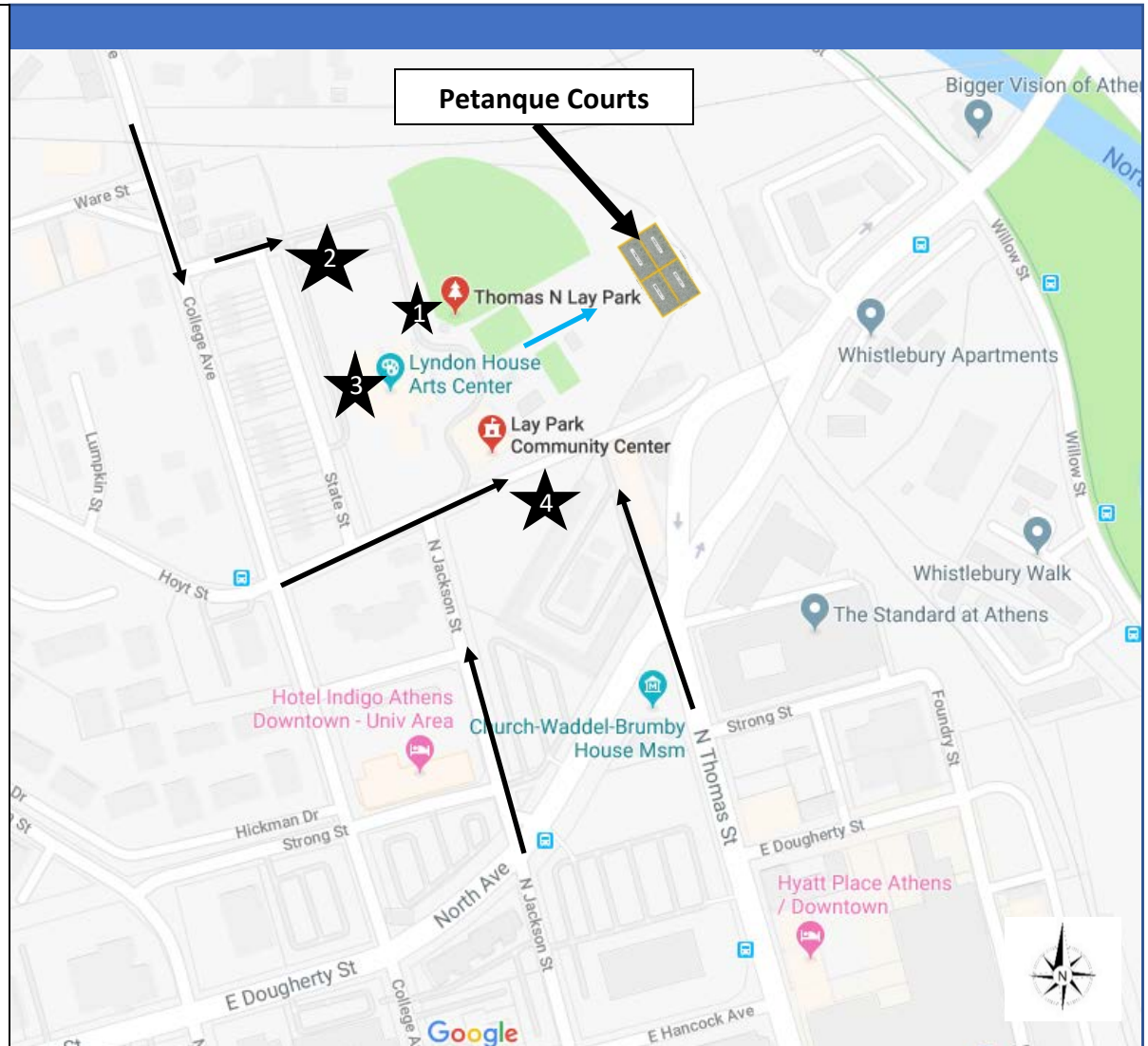
Petanque terrain at Lay Park and Community Center, 297 Hoyt Street.

Access Hoyt Street from North Avenue (turn right into The Foundry, drive straight through, then turn left), from downtown on North Jackson Street and North Thomas Street, and from College Avenue.

Four free parking areas are available:

1. Between the Lyndon House and the baseball field is the closest parking.
2. Next is behind the Lyndon House.
3. In front of the Lyndon House Art Center, and
4. In front of the Lay Community Center on Hoyt Street are slightly further away.

The courts (pistes) are located at about 100 yards from parking area 1. They are on the northeastern end of the park, as identified on the map. Walk past the basketball and tennis courts and pool and continue beyond the picnic shelter and tables. You'll see the wooden fencing and stairs leading down to the four new pistes as you descend the hill.



The pistes are beyond the pool and tennis courts approximately 100 yards from parking area 1.

When parked in front of the Lay Community Center, climb the steps, or take the ramp just left of the steps, and walk between the community center building and pool complex, then turn right and follow the sidewalk between the basketball courts and pool complex and tennis courts to the pistes.

When parked at or behind the Lyndon House, proceed to the baseball field, turn left and follow the sidewalk between the basketball courts and pool complex and tennis courts. Park in the designated parking spaces. The paved areas behind the Community Center and beside the Arts Center are for Leisure Services vehicles and maintenance access only.
